THE Committee appointed at the Parish Meeting on July 5th, 1917, to consider this matter have held several meetings and unanimously decided that the Memorial ought to be of a permanent character, and that the Market Place afforded the most suitable site. They approached the Rural District Council, who, being in full sympathy with the desire to do honour to our Sailors and Soldiers, readily gave permission for the erection of such a memorial in the centre of the Town.

The Committee obtained designs from four firms and choose one by Messrs. J. & H. Patteson of 96 Oxford Street, Manchester, a drawing of which is shewn on this Circular. The cost is estimated at about $\pounds 280$.

At the Parish Meeting a suggestion was made and favourably received that a Roll of Honour on parchment containing particulars of all the men who have served during the present War, their rank, promotion and honours, should be presented to the Parish Council for preservation amongst the Parish Records. The Committee fully approve of this proposal. The preparation of such a Roll of Honour would involve considerable time, trouble and expense and should be begun at once. It is hoped that the present appeal may provide sufficient funds for both purposes. Should there be a balance it will be handed over to the Committee that will be charged with the provision of a Peace Memorial.

The larger the number of subscribers the more completely shall we show our gratitude to those who have risked, and alas, in too many cases lost, their lives for their Country. It is therefore hoped that every Family in the Parish will contribute in order that the Memorial may be Parochial in the fullest sense.

Subscriptions will be received by any member of the Committee and at the local Banks where the Managers have kindly agreed to open lists.

Chapel-en-le-Frith Parish Council Minutes

Extracts re War Memorial

1 August 1917

It was reported that the Roll of Honour Committee had been appointed on 5 July 1917.

The Committee were seeking permission to erect the Roll of Honour on the Market Place.

The cost of the stone Memorial and cut names was £225 and a public subscription appeal was launched.

2 January 1918

The Committee sought approval to move the one existing street light on the Market Place to allow for the erection of the Memorial and suggested that if this was approved that 3 lights be erected at:

1 street lamp at Town Gate

- 1 bracket lamp attached to the Swan Inn
- 1 bracket lamp attached to the Manchester County Bank

The Council arranged a site meeting on the Market Place and agreed the proposals at a Special Meeting held on 5 January 1918.

30 January 1918

The Committee approached the Council to erect 4 ornamental lamps, one at each corner of the base of the Monument, which were 'to be carried out in harmony with the Monument with a scheme that would add to the overall appearance'.

10 April 1918

The Council agreed to pay the cost of the 4 ornamental lamps at £50 in total.

18 June 1919

The design of the 4 ornamental lamps were agreed and ordered.

6 August 1919

The Council agreed to take over the future maintenance of the Memorial at the request of the Committee.

3 December 1919

The supports and chains were added to the 4 ornamental lamps around the Memorial.

A WISH GRANTED.

At the Chapel-en-le-Frith Police Court an unusual charge, that of wilfully damaging a memorial, / was preferred against an itinerant, Geo. Wilson.

P.C. Hallam said that at noon the day previously he was standing in the Market Place, Chapel, and saw the defendant walk from the direction of the King's Arms towards the ts Chapel war memorial. He took something, a or file and two knives wrapped in paper, from his i- pocket and deliberately smashed one of the glass globes on the memorial. When asked by the witness what he had done it for, the defendant replied : "I want locking up."

Mr. J. F. Mellor, the clerk to the Parish Council, said it was difficult to assess the damage, owing to the inability of the Council to replace a lamp broken previously that was identical with the remaining three.

The defendant, who pleaded guilty, refused to give any explanation of himself.

The Clerk: Did you realise it was a war memorial?

The defendant: I looked at the glass. It was handy, and I wanted locking up, because I am tired of walking about this wet weather.

The defendant, when asked about his occupation, said that the police force could give evidence on that. He said it would be a mere waste of breath to explain his conduct.

Superintendent Macdonald proved previous convictions against the defendant, who was sent to prison for two months.
