

Special Meeting of the Chappel-en-le-Frith  
Parish Council in the "Old Mechanic's Institute"  
Market Street, Chappel-en-le-Frith, on Monday the 25<sup>th</sup>  
day of March 1895. at seven o'clock p.m.

Attendance Present - Col Hall (presiding), Messrs Bramwell, Morten,  
Spencer, Lomas (B) Reynolds, Keyworth, Marchington,  
Lomas (J) and J Ford (clerk)

Minutes The minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Then signed by the Chairman

The Council then proceeded with the election of Surveyors of Highways.

Election of Mr Morten proposed. Mr Spencer seconded.  
Surveyor of Highways That Mr Stephen Gregory be appointed the Surveyor of Bradshaw Edge for the ensuing year

Mr Bramwell proposed. Mr Reynolds seconded  
That Mr Thomas Howarth, the retiring Surveyor be re-elected.

The Chairman then put the names to the vote, when Mr Stephen Gregory received three votes viz - Messrs Morten, Spencer, and Lomas (B)

Mr Howarth received five votes viz - Col Hall, Messrs Bramwell, Reynolds, Keyworth & Marchington.

For Bradshaw Edge Mr Howarth was therefore declared elected

Mr Heyworth proposed, Mr Marchington seconded  
for Bowden Edge That Mr John Marchington be the Surveyor for Bowden Edge  
 carried unanimously

Mr Lomas (B) proposed, Mr Morten seconded,  
for Combs Edge That Mr Henry Morten be appointed the Surveyor for  
 Combs Edge  
 carried unanimously

In accordance with notice previously given Mr Bramwell  
 then proposed -

Taking of That the Rooms situated in Market Street, and known  
Rooms as as the Old Mechanic's Institute" be taken for the  
Office &c. Place of Meeting, and Office of the Parish Council,  
 at the weekly rental of two shillings and sixpence  
 Mr Marchington seconded the Proposition and  
 it was Carried unanimously

Mr Bramwell Then carried out his notice of  
Time of meetings Motion given at the last meeting, viz -  
 That the Ordinary Meetings of the Council be  
 held on the second Monday in each month.

Mr Morten seconded

Mr Reynolds moved an Amendment to the effect -  
 That the meetings of the Council be held on the  
 Last Monday in each month.

Mr Spencer Seconded.

The proposer & Seconder of the Resolution, consenting  
 to support the Amendment; it was therefore  
 carried unanimously

Mr Reynolds then gave notice -
