The Council went to view the site of the
alleged encroachment. On their return

Mr Reynolds proposed Mr Keyworth seconded
That the following reply be sent to the
Requisitionists—

The Parish Council having fully investigated
the question raised in your communication of the
14th inst, has come to the conclusion that in its
opinion the plans for the proposed Erection
show an undoubted encroachment upon the public
right of way. Further that in consideration of
the fact that the existing way will be in one place
widened by the proposed new building, and
further that Mr^s Walton is prepared to take
down the Brick Building now existing and
to restore the site thereof to the road, and
further that from a Sanitary point of view the
new erection would be an improvement; the
Council considers that in this case it is not
desirable for it at present to take any action in
the matter

Carried unanimously

It was also proposed by Mr Lomas (J) and
Seconded by Mr Keyworth

a complaint of an alleged encroachment being made,
