Highway Mr Shaw was represented by Mr Goodman, Solicitor,
situate at who produced a map of the Highway above named
White Hall and also fully explained the matter.

On the motion of Mr Lomas (J) seconded by Mr Barnes
the following Resolution was unanimously passed.

"That on the application of Henry Shaw of White Hall
in the Parishes of Fernilee and Chapel-en-le-Frith in
the County of Derby Esquire, the Council hereby
Consents that a portion of the old Highway leading
from Whaley Bridge to Buxton and situate in the
Parish of Fernilee within the district of the Rural District
Council of Chapel-en-le-Frith, should be stopped up and
diverted viz - that so much of the said Highway as it
now exists which commences at a point north of White Hall
aforesaid where it is joined by the private carriage
drive (passing on the north side of the Garden to
the turnpike road) and passes thence in a southeasterly
direction towards Buxton as lies between the Said
junction with the private carriage drive and a
point 415 yards southwest thereof, ^{should} shall be entirely
stopped up and that the said Highway shall be
diverted or turned between the said two points
so as to pass to the east of the stables and
outbuildings of the said Henry Shaw at White Hall
aforesaid and so that the portion of the said highway
so proposed to be diverted shall be of the length
of 405 yards and shall be situate in the
Parish of Chapel-en-le-Frith instead of being of
the length of 415 yards and situate in the Parish
of Fernilee as at present; but if in case at any
future time, highway shall be again repaired by
their respective parishes, instead of out of the
general district rate as at present, then the portion
of the above mentioned highway proposed to be diverted
into the Parish of Chapel-en-le-Frith shall not be
reparable by such parish.

On the motion of Mr Keyworth seconded by Mr Spencer
The accounts of Mr Hunter for Chairs and the Clerk
Accounts for audit stamp amounting to £3 - 12 - 6
were passed.

Mr Smith gave notice that at the next meeting of the
Notice of Motion Council the appointment of Treasurer shall be
considered.
