paid by the Council  
Carried unanimously.

Letter to be sent to owners of Gas Works Proposed by Mr Morten Seconded by Mr Smith  
That the attention of the owners of the Gas Company and  
also the lighting Inspectors be drawn to the very bad  
quality of the gas as supplied to the Town, and that  
they be requested to take such steps as will lead to  
an improvement as early as possible  
Carried unanimously.

The question of Better postal facilities It was proposed by Mr Lomas (J) and seconded by Mr Lomas (B)  
 That in the interests of the town it is desirable to have three despatches and three deliveries of letters during the day  
 The first despatch to be early enough to ensure a reply the same day, and that the Clerk be instructed to communicate with Mr Bramwell, the postmaster, and request him to forward the application to the proper quarter

Carried unanimously.

 That the Assistant Overseer be allowed the sum of £10 (as recommended by the Overseers) for Collecting the Special Sanitary Rate.
